God's Economy: To Each His own

“And the land shall yield her fruit, and ye shall eat your fill, and dwell therein safety.”

Leviticus 25:19

During a financial recession or downturn such as that the country is experiencing, many of us find ourselves pressed by the realities of the loss of jobs, reductions of income, and rising costs of living. In reality, the people of God are not immune to such effects. We too know the impact of economic recessions, lower stock prices and unemployment. We too are acquainted with the stresses and pressures of survival which are the norm for so many in today's society. Yet those of us in pursuit of fullness in this season know of a different reality. Those of us who are the believers in Christ, and therefore heirs to the Kingdom, are not overcome by the world's recession. We are different in at least two ways:

1. We are connected to a different economy whose source is the storehouse of Heaven and thus, we do not depend solely on the effectiveness and justice of the markets.
2. We are connected to a different economy, and thus we are not emotionally broken or overwhelmed with the anxieties that tend to break one's spirit and rob one of his or her joy in times of difficulty or challenge.

Our text of focus instructs the Hebrews that they are to enter the land of promise and, systematically every fiftieth year, restore unto each clan or family their rightful provision of land which the Lord promised would bear fruit. In other words, God promises that no condition of want, lack, oppression, or poverty is to be permanent for us. In God's economy there is always a restoration of fortunes, a reversal of bad times, a renewal of prosperity that belongs to each one of us who bears His name!

God promises bread on our tables! (Matthew 6:11; Matthew 6:31-32; Matthew 7:7; Philippians 4:19). No recession can prohibit what God has established through His word as promise to His people! Recognize that you are a part of God's economy who can and will bless you with the fullness He promises. There is bread for you too! God has a will. And God has a way. Trust Him!

Pray this:

Lord today, help me to depend solely on your economy through which you distribute your fullness to me. I trust in your provision and your care for me. I know and believe that in your economy there is bread for my table too.
