Proverbs 3:9-10

I am always intrigued at the promises the world makes. Toyota tells you, “You’ll love it” when you drive their cars. Campbell’s Soup tells you its product is mmm’ good”. The makers of Pantene Shampoo and Conditioner tell you their product “leaves your hair silky smooth” (are they really talking about *us*?). And of course, Maxwell House coffee is, “Good to the last drop”. But here’s one that really sticks with me. Men’s Warehouse tells you, “You’re going to like the way you look, I guarantee it!” Wow. They went a step further. They guaranteed success. I’m not sure if they can keep it. But I know who can.
