## Another Man's Treasure

Of all the attributes of David, it was his worship of God through praise, which revealed the most about him. David praised God for many reasons. The Psalms as a whole teach us this.

David had praised God for:

His deliverance (Psalm 34:4)

His mercy and goodness (Psalm 100:4-5)

His greatness and protection and power (Psalm 62:7; Psalm 63:7)

His loving-kindness (Psalm 42:8)

His favor (Psalm 30:5)

Yet there is still another reason David praised God which often goes unnoticed. David found the revelation that God was worthy to be praised because of how our great Jehovah had "fearfully and wonderfully" made him. What does it mean?

*It means that God took His time with David, took special care with him,  
To craft this man of God in exactly the way God desired.  
For David, God was the master craftsman and David was His masterpiece!  
David looked into the mirror of God's face to determine his own worth and value.  
This man of God know he was somebody special,  
Because the mirror does not lie.*

Hear the word:

I know a man named Jesus who can't take His eyes off of you.  
Though you were told by many that you are a man who will never amount to anything,  
I know a man named Jesus who is fighting all your battles.*
