The person who created the fraudulent persona on MySpace claimed in one police report that she did it in order to see what the now deceased 14-year-old girl was saying about her daughter. Her curiosity turned deadly. Guided by suspicion, distrust, fear, and hostility, this mother's tactics took her farther than she intended to go. Her scheme spun out of control. She now has to live everyday knowing that she aided in the suicide of a depressed, lonely, innocent child.

***We must always be on guard against our own fits of anger, revenge, rage, and frustration.  
These emotions do not belong to the devil, they belong to us.  
Out from these emotions emerge hostilities  
which can so easily take us farther than we really want to go,  
and lead us to harm God's people and ourselves in ways we really can't control.***

In our text of focus, instead of seeking the face of those he believed was out to do him harm, David determined to seek the Lord's face. He trusted in the Lord for his vindication, his liberation, and his ultimate protection. Healed from the sicknesses of anger and revenge, He refused to be drawn into a war with people whom the Lord **also** was committed to loving and protecting. God doesn't take sides in the fights we start, nor does He take delight in the ones we think we're big and bad enough to finish.

***Our loving God and Father never uses one of His children  
to exact punishment and judgment upon another of His children.  
God does not need me to do His dirty work. Leave what is the Lord's, to the Lord.***
